

2010 Marshfield Motor Speedway Junkyard Warrior Rules

Safety:

- Must have fire extinguisher
- Must have Snell 85 helmet. Nomax Face Cover Recommended!
- Must wear approved Fireproof Race Uniform
- All flammable parts must be removed from car
- Car may be American or Foreign made
- Car to appear neatly, brightly painted and lettered, no offensive logos
- Body of car must appear street ready and recognizable by spectators as to what type of car it is
- No wheelbases above 111"
- All glass but windshield must be removed. Lexan windshield highly recommended.
- All inner fenders and parts must remain intact. Bumpers must be on.
- Mandatory 6-point roll cage. Cage - 1 3/4" .095 thickness made of roll bar tubing. No muffler pipe allowed. Mandatory 3 drivers side and 2 passenger side door bars.

Motors:

- No motors above 3810 cc, NO tolerance.
- 4-Cyl may have factory turbo only.
- Motors must match car for body style. 4-Cyl. Dual Overhead Cam engines allowed. No high performance engines.
- OEM parts only, no racing parts. All parts must have original manufacturers stamp. NO machine work of any type allowed!
- No compression on motor allowed above 170 psi after race. Test taken with track compression gauge.
- Fuel system must be original for year of vehicle. Carburetor for carburetor, injectors for injectors, no switching. Do not remove the fuel tank. Call the tech inspector if the fuel tank is behind the rear axle.

- No Computer Chips allowed.
- No inline 6 Cylinder motors
- Factory motor, per car, per make
- Air cleaners in engine compartment. No hood scoops.

Suspension:

- Manufacturers only. No race parts, no machined parts, no traction devices added.
- 4" minimum ground clearance.
- Camber is unlimited, Tire/wheel limited to 1" outside original designed manufacturer fender!
- Slotted struts allowed
- Tire(s) must not stick out more than 1 inch past fenders
- Racing wheels allowed (for safety)

Weight:

- After race, 4-Cyl 2400 lbs, 6-cyl 2600 lbs. Must have 4-cyl or 6-cyl ID and readable by scale personal.
- Rear wheel drive cars must add 300 lbs to vehicle
- Weight may be added to RS of car for competition reasons only

Wheels & Tires:

- 7" maximum stock steel rims. 1" lug nuts. Front or rear wheel drive, no four wheel drives. Any 13", 14" or 15" tire, 60 series or narrower tires allowed.

Measurements:

- Taken with driver and all equipment in the car.

Misc:

- Anyone entering another team's pit area and causing unfavorable conditions, WILL be penalized their points and money for the evening.
- There will be a \$25 fine for speeding in the pits. Second offense is \$100 fine, and the third offensive is disqualification for remainder of the year.
- Rough driving will result in loss of points/pay, second offense will result in suspension from the track!
- Anyone disrespecting a track official will lose pay/points for that night. Second offense will result in suspension from the track!
- This is suppose to be a fun division and will be treated as such!
